CHAPTER AWARD

AWARD CATEGORIES, DEFINITION AND ELIGIBILITY

The concepts of "recognition" and "praise" are two critical components for creating positive emotions in organizations.

AWARD ONE: ACADEMIC EXCELLENCE AWARD

Definition: One who has a proven track record of scientific contributions and leadership positions.

Eligibility:

1. The candidate should be well respected (internationally) for his research contributions and publications (books, papers and patents) and have won major awards and recognitions in the academic world.
2. And/or the candidate has held top position (s) in (nationally and internationally) well known higher education institutions such as reputed graduate or business schools.
3. Has a proven track record of his/her students going on to become successful entrepreneurs / executives/academicians.
4. Others - At least 5 years in career.
5. Member - A member of the chapter and from the chapter geographical area.

AWARD TWO: ENTREPRENEURIAL ACHIEVEMENT AWARD

Definition: One who has been a successful entrepreneur with proven track record of sustained wealth/value and job creation and has made positive social and environmental impact.

Eligibility:

1. The candidate must be a successful serial entrepreneur with clear visibility in a Colorado Organization(s) are well known.
2. Should have demonstrated significant job and wealth/value creation. His/her journey showcases brand IIT as a self-made man.
3. Should have sustained impact, instead of "cash out and flame out".
4. Preferably with some evidence of giving back to the society and has positive impact on the environment. Invited speakers to high profile events. Connections with well-known NGOs.
5. Other - Minimum 5 years in career
6. Member - A member of the chapter and from the chapter geographical area.

AWARD THREE: CORPORATE EXCELLENCE AWARD

Definition: One who has held positions at well-known corporations and has a proven track record of sustained wealth/value and job creation and has made positive social and environmental impact.

Eligibility:

1. The candidate must have held top position(s) in well-known corporations and garnered clear visibility in the Colorado and USA.
2. Has overseen tremendous growth enabling significant employment and wealth creation. Corporation is globally visible.
3. Have received reputed awards and recognitions.
4. Invited speaker to high profile events.
5. Other - Minimum 10 years in career
6. Member - A member of the chapter and from the chapter geographical area.

AWARD FOUR: TECHNOLOGY LEADERSHIP AWARD

Definition: One who has a proven track record as an inventor or product developer and through his/her contributions helped in jobs and wealth/value creation.

Eligibility:

1. The candidate has been credited with creating disruptive technology/product innovation and garnered clear visibility in the USA.
2. Must have led to practical, mainstream productization resulting in job creation and/or significant efficiency gains.
3. Has earned major patents or credited with a major invention or product having a positive social or environmental impact.
4. Invited speakers to high profile events. Has won major awards/recognition.
5. Other - Minimum 10 years in career
6. Member - A member of the chapter and from the chapter geographical area.

AWARD FIVE: SOCIAL ENTREPRENEURSHIP AWARD

Definition: One who has demonstrated leadership for social upliftment and made significant impact in Colorado, or rest of USA (and elsewhere).

Eligibility:

1. The candidate has been credited starting and/or providing leadership for social upliftment program(s) and has garnered clear visibility globally.
2. Demonstrated significant positive impact within the USA (and elsewhere).
3. Must be directly involved with the cause.
4. Associated with globally recognized NGO.
5. Other - Minimum 5 years in career.
6. Member - A member of the chapter and from the chapter geographical area.
