Sudhakar Shenoy



Sudhakar Shenoy is the Founder, Chairman, and Chief Executive Officer of Alyx Technologies, Inc., a business solutions and technology provider with operations in the United States and India. Mr. Shenoy was a member of the Non-Resident Indian Advisory Group that advised the former Prime Minister of India on strategies for attracting foreign direct investment. Mr. Shenoy was inducted into the Alumni Hall of Fame at the University of Connecticut School of Business and was recognized as a Distinguished Alumnus of the IIT in Bombay, India in 1997. Mr. Shenoy was recently named Top 25 Most Influential People in Washington, D.C. high tech industry as well as being awarded the 2004 Executive of the Year by the Northern Virginia Government Contractors Council.

Along with a dozen other Fortune 500 CEO's, Mr. Shenoy was selected for several Presidential trade and development missions to India (1995), Spain (1995), and Berlin (1999). In 2000, the Speaker of the Virginia State Legislature appointed Mr. Shenoy to a five-member citizens committee on the Virginia Legislative Process. Mr. Shenoy was a founding director of IGC (NASDAQ: IGC), past director of Startec Global (also a NASDAQ company), GTT (public company). He is also on the board of several private companies.

Mr. Shenoy holds a B. Tech (Hons.) in electrical engineering from the Indian Institute of Technology and an M.S. in Electrical Engineering and an M.B.A. from the University of Connecticut Schools of Engineering and Business Administration, respectively.
